## CURRENT POSITION

I teach various courses across the curriculum (clinical supervision of nursing students in P/CHN), C/PHN in the RN/BSN program, research and EBP, and population health in the master's program. I also taught population health in the accelerated BSN and DNP program in collaboration with the University of Toledo.
